Purpose: The *Hispanic Bar Association of Houston* will award **two** \$2,000 scholarships to deserving third-year law students at each of the three Houston area law schools (for a total of six [6] scholarships). The scholarships are designed to assist economically disadvantaged students in fulfilling their professional aspirations by paying for a portion of the cost associated with a bar review study course.

Eligibility: The scholarships will be awarded based primarily on (i) demonstrated leadership and commitment toward the advancement of Hispanics in the legal profession and/or the community and (ii) financial need. To be considered for the scholarship, you must be a paid member of your law school's Hispanic law students association and a third-year law student graduating in either December 2009 or May 2010.
